Swirling Dream-Wreck Fu-On Chung and Sam Thomas Wednesday 2 August – Saturday 26 August Accompanying text *What Lies beneath* by Francis McWhannell

Artist Talk: Wednesday 2 August: 12pm, noon.

*Swirling Dream-Wreck* is the second iteration of an ongoing collaboration between Auckland-based painters, Fu-On Chung and Sam Thomas. The first collaborative exhibition, *Nets* (GLOVEBOX, October 2016), saw the artists focus on tennis—their contrasting practices, abstraction and figuration, each describing different angles on the game.

In *Swirling Dream-Wreck* Chung and Thomas look at the concept of fantasy with equally diverse approaches, using their shared medium of painting to expand and evolve elements of a shared unknown.

**Fu-On Chung** (1991) is a painter and founding member of GLOVEBOX.
